Steven Strickland Announces Candidacy for State House District 119

Growing Network of Support from Athens and Oconee

Athens, Georgia, January 24, 2018 – Steven Strickland, an Oconee County Republican, announced his candidacy for State Representative (District 119) in the upcoming 2018 General Election. District 119 includes portions of Athens-Clarke County and Oconee County.

“I’m excited to run in a district with a reputation of being the best home in Georgia for families and with so many people striving to keep conservative values prevalent in the community,” Strickland stated. Previously, Steven served 2 years leading volunteer activities and fundraising for a 90-member chapter of a non-profit in the local area.
